> Entrance rules


- Users (both student & staff) would have to sign their respective registers.


> Rare books


Rare books are traditionally the heart of an academic library. They represent the intellectual and literary heritage of the written word.

- Reference Services:-The users can go through the details of a book by consulting the librarian. The librarian provides the factual answers to the questions.
